•Have you heard of the Mormons?

•Have you wondered why Mormons build temples throughout the world?

•Do you believe that God speaks to prophets today as He did to prophets in the past?

If there is a question you could ask God, what would it be?

Have you ever heard of the Book of Mormon?

•What do you believe happens to those people who never hear of Jesus Christ? Are they damned? Or does God have a provision in place to rescue these souls?

•Have you ever wondered why there are no prophets on the earth today? What would you think if I told you that there really are prophets on the earth today?

•Do you believe that marriages and families will continue to be together after this life?

•How do you stay close to God?

•What do you do to ensure that you are living in accordance with the commandments of God?

•Any of the ten survey questions are terrific GQs to ask frequently as well.



There are a limitless number of questions you can ask. Try them out and find the set of questions that work best for you. For me, I found my best GQ questions are

1. Have you heard of the Mormons?

2. Have you ever asked yourself "Where did I come from? Why am I here on earth? And where am I going after I die?"

I found that these two GQ approaches are thought-provoking enough to get people talking. Getting people to talk is the key. These two questions are also neutral and uncontroversial.
